Planning

The main items on the April matrix follow. **Bondville Model Village** – Erection of a replacement building for use as tea rooms following demolition of existing with associated works and improvement of existing car park. We welcome those improved facilities at Sewerby village. **Land South and West of Mill Lane Water Treatment Works** – Erection of 96 dwellings (outline already approved) regarding water drainage, open space provision. affordable housing, wildlife enhancement, archaeology etc. Our Secretary will comment on the need for the link road to take priority. **25 King Street** – Change of use of first and second floors to create four flats. It was felt that more residential accommodation would encourage people to move back into the town.

Eastern Area Planning Sub-Committee – We await online information with respect to the agenda of the April meeting.
